SPOTLIGHT ON YOUR COACH – MIKE LYNCH UNDER 11s RANGERS



Q. How did you first get involved with coaching at Parkdale Sidac?

A. My son was in the academy & the coach was unable to move up with the team, so I stepped forward with another parent to take on the team. We felt that if we didn't no-one else would!

Q. How long have you been coaching?

A. I'd never coached before that, so it was good to learn & there was plenty of help available from more experienced coaches. It's been 5 years since I started.

Q. What has been your stand out moment in that time?

A. There's been so many, from seeing their first ever game to thrilling matches. Stand out is probably winning the Earlestown tournament a few years ago.

Q. What is your motivation for being involved with junior football?

A. I genuinely enjoy being part of the coaching team & seeing the kids develop, developing their teamwork & skills.

Q. What skills/qualities do you think are necessary for coaching?

A. Patience is really important as kids all learn at different rates & not having fixed ideas. You're always learning.

Q. How do you manage volunteering with home and work too?

A. I'm lucky to be sharing the work with other coaches in our team, but once you're up and running it's pretty straightforward most of the time.

Q. What have you learned about yourself since you started coaching?

A. I've realised that it isn't all about winning. When we first started it mattered too much! As coaches we're now trying to develop the players more. The players are too young to pick permanent positions, they need to try various positions to learn the game properly.

Q. How do you think the club is being run & what improvements would you like to see made?

A. The club is well organised and really supportive. I'm really looking forward to moving to our new home at Sherdley.

Q. What advice would you give to someone thinking about getting involved in coaching?

A. It is massively rewarding, great to be involved and see the kids' development over the years.
